point out that the Plaintiffs seem to be claiming both comes and interest but nowhere is the Defendant's liability for such comes or interest stablished nor is any breakdown of the eques and interest given.

F. Accordingly, I respectfully ask that the Defendant be given unconditional leave to defend this action. On the 6th October 1980 I personally prepared a Defence which was subnequently filed and served. I am nowinformed by Commel that he would wish to put in a substantially smended Defence which would deal with all the matters to which I refer above. however, Commel says that he cannot do so until the Flaintiffs' claim is properly pleaded. It is for this reason that no draft Amended Defence is annexed to this Afficavit
